



MPE ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

MPE Limited (MPE) recognises that its operations have an effect on the environment and is committed to preventing pollution, minimising any negative effects and maximising any positive effects created by its operations. The company will do this by integrating consideration of environmental issues into decision-making processes and by a programme of continual improvement. It is the company's policy to comply fully with the requirements of environmental legislation, industry regulations and any advisory codes of practice having official status. The company will however, exceed these requirements insofar as it is practicable for it to do so and that definite environmental benefits would be achieved.

To meet these aims and to promote the principle of sustainable development the company has specific environmental policies, objectives and targets as detailed below:

Energy Consumption

The company is committed to improving energy efficiencies in line with government policies to reduce carbon emissions and introduce sustainable energy production. To this end the company will promote programmes to attain greater energy efficiencies and seek to source its energy requirements from sustainable resources in line with business needs.

Hazardous Materials

The company has eliminated the use of all Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) and will work to maintain this status.

Packaging

The company will use 100% recyclable packaging materials wherever possible and appropriate.

Procurement

The company will work to ensure that its procurement processes consider the increased use of sustainable products and endeavours to procure goods with reduced environmental impacts.

Single Use Plastics

The company has eliminated the use of all 'single use' plastics and will work to maintain this status.

Waste Management

The company will review opportunities and implement measures to reduce the volume of waste generated and to increase the proportion of waste which is segregated and may be recycled.

Water Usage

The company will review opportunities and implement measures for reducing the use of water in line with business needs.
